

Compliance with DMV Driver Regulations for Firefighters

Course Overview: (This will be the same information that was presented in Los Banos in February 2012)

Assembly Bill 1648 was authored by Assemblyman Kevin Jeffries in order to clarify the licensing requirements for a firefighter in the operation of fire department equipment. That regulation took effect January 01, 2011

Since that time there has been a lot of information distributed that caused some confusion and in some cases concerns for fire chiefs around the state. This workshop is an effort to provide a summary of the options that are available and the processes that your local fire agency can employ to stay current on driver's license requirement.
