## **REGISTERING FOR STATE FIRE TRAINING (CFSTES) COURSES AT SRJC**

The Fire Program at SRJC is proud to offer a number of State Fire Training (SFT) CFSTES courses including those required to obtain a Company Officer certificate all within a one year period. To ensure there will be seats available for fire service personnel these courses are listed as "Restricted" (which is required under the Education Code). While having an obvious benefit, it does add an additional step in the registration process. The purpose of this document is to provide a step-by-step guide on how to enroll in these courses at SRJC.

### **Submit an Application to SRJC**

\*if you are a continuing SRJC student, please skip to **Submit Challenge Forms**

1. Log on to [www.santarosa.edu](http://www.santarosa.edu)
2. Click the "Students" tab found on the blue banner along the top of the page
3. Click "Apply Online"
4. Click "New or Returning Student"
5. Click the "Open CCC" picture
6. Create an account
7. Log into your account using the user name and password you created
8. Once in the application, make sure you choose the semester for which you will be attending and under "Educational Goal" select either "Maintain Certificate or License" or "Educational Development"
